Re: Live Burn Training

Tilton-Northfield Fire & EMS, with permission from Planet Honda and Autoserv, has acquired the buildings at 80 East Main Street, 4 Morrison Avenue, and 6 Morrison Avenue for live-burn training. This training is scheduled for September 20, 2020, and will commence at 5:00 am and will conclude at noon.

We have obtained the proper permits from the NH Department of Environmental Services and will follow the requirements of the National Fire Protection Agency 1403 – Standard for Live Fire Evolutions.

The purpose of this training is to give our firefighters experience under actual fire conditions. You may see several different fire department vehicles operating in the area on the day of the training as all three houses will have live fire evolutions taking place at the same time. Our goal is to maximize firefighter training with as little disruption to the surrounding area as possible.
