## New Engine Arrives

After sitting in Vermont at the dealership for nearly four months, finally, our new engine has arrived. We expect to put it in service within 2 to 3 weeks.

Group 3 (Lt Hall's shift) is responsible for putting the vehicle in service. We/they are extremely open to and will welcome any and all suggestions and assistance with placing equipment, etc. But, please check with Lt Hall before you make any changes or improvements—

somebody has to have overall responsibility, along with the ability to coordinate the process.

Appointments have already been made to install the radio and to have the lettering done.

The truck should be registered next week. Please check with one of the officers to get training on the vehicle. Nobody is to drive the vehicle without being approved by one of our officers.

When the engine goes in service, it will be 21 Engine 3. It will run first

due out of the Center Street Station. 21E1 will become the 2nd due engine; or, first due on 2nd calls. 21E2 will be the water supply engine. The tanker will remain as 2nd due to all fire calls.

Please stop by to see the truck and set up a time to drive it and train with it. Thank you for all your support. This engine enhances our fleet of apparatus and will make us more efficient and effective in delivering quality service to the public.
